

SPICE TOUR

The half-day tour. This is a guided walking tour passes through villages and spice plantations, a walk through the farms as spice farms workers climbs trees, seek out specific plants and cuts off various barks, letting you see, feel and taste everything. At the Spice farms is the best place to buy fresh spices directly from the source.



STONE TOWN TOUR

PRISON ISLAND TOUR

The island lies just off the Old Stone Town, it is also a home to **giant land tortoises** that were imported from Seychelles in the late 19th century. Now it is more commonly known as a home of Zanzibar's **Giant Aldabran Tortoise** colony, some of which are over a hundred years old. Once on the island, you have the opportunity to feed and pet the tortoises; if you have time you may also like to take a stroll through the forested interior where you will see a wide variety of birds, colorful peacocks. It is fringed with a beautiful coral reef, ideal for snorkeling, and has a lovely white beach for sunbathing.



NUNGWI VILLAGE TOUR

This is the best trip that gives you the scope to discover the life of local fisherman of the island. It offers variety things and activities to do; including fish market, traditional boat yard and interacting with local people.



COOKING LESSON

We go back to the traditional cooking by explaining the origins of spices, their significance in Zanzibar cuisine and using the old methods as practiced by our ancestors.



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DOLPHIN TOUR

The most popular dolphin spotting location in Zanzibar is in **Kizimkazi village** located on the Southern coast of Zanzibar Island where you can see both bottle-nose and humpback dolphins. Several bottle-nose dolphins stay at Kizimkazi all year-round. There are also rather shy humpback dolphins that put in an appearance here, although their schedule is a little more erratic. Dolphin tour is best very early in the morning, because in the afternoon as the sun rises sea water tends to become warm, therefore dolphins dive deep down the sea bottom to escape heat, for the guests who stay in Stone town hotel, we pick them up from their hotels at 06:00am and 05:00am from beach hotels.

This is a guided trip and private transfers to and from Hotel, we intend to make our clients more comfortable and more free.



SAFARI BLUE TOUR

Safari Blue starts from the village of Fumba. Fumba is the most convenient location for exploring the wildlife, isolated sandbanks and rugged island scenery of the Menai Bay Conservation Area. This trip starts from the village of Fumba in South West Zanzibar and we will take you to see the **dolphins, sandbanks, islands and coral reefs** of Menai Bay, a beautiful conservation area. In the morning we set down on one of the beautiful sandbanks where one can relax, swim or snorkel. There are plenty of good quality snorkeling equipment and the experienced snorkeling guides will show you the pristine coral reef, which teems with tropical sea life. Instruction is also available for beginners, fresh coconuts and local snacks are available throughout the day. This tour includes Lunch of a delicious Zanzibar seafood lunch with grilled fish and slipper lobster. Join the crew for a sail on an “ngalawa”- a local canoe with outriggers which has been carved from a single mango tree.
