

Pamplemousse Garden / Chateau de Labourdonnais, Grand Baie, Cap Malheureux

Discover the Capital city of Mauritius, Port-Louis, the island's hub with its 170000 inhabitants. Start from the **Fort Adelaide**, a citadel built in 1834 - English period, where you will have a breathtaking view of the capital city and its harbor.

Go through the local **Chinatown** where many of the houses date from the period around 1900, and walk down to the **traditional Central Market**, visited daily by more than 30,000 people, to discover the Cultural diversity of the island.

After a traditional Mauritian lunch in a charming and typical restaurant in the district of Pamplemousse.

*EITHER: continue the day with the visit Pamplemousse Botanical Garden - created during French colonial period with the aim of making of Mauritius a Spice Island. Where, today the garden gathers a large collection of plants from across the world.

*OR: Head to the small town of Mapou to the Chateau de Labourdonnais, a 1859 colonial building which will bring you back to the 19th century. Discover the garden and its magnificent arboretum on the **Domaine's Express Train** and taste the local fruit paste and sorbet made from their fruits and the Chateau itself.

At the end of the visits, our guide will bring you to **Grand Baie**, a lively small coastal town in the North and to **Cap Malheureux** Village where its church is hard to miss.



Port -Louis, Fort Adelaide, China Town, Central Market, Caudan Waterfront, Blue Penny Museum

Walk down the roads of the **Capital city** along with one of our guides and discover the secrets of Port -Louis, the island's hub. During the day, this small city founded in 1736 is a busy cauldron of activity.

Our guide will bring you to the **Chinatown**. Small shops and arts and craft businesses are located on the ground floor while people live on the floor above. Discover these exotic shops and taste some of the **Sino Mauritian delicacies**.

You will come across some of the street food specialties such as the (Gato Zinli) a sesame balls, (Pao) a bun bread filled usually filled with pork and, deep fried Taro Roots, "Boulettes".

Folklore and tradition. The **Market** is anbusy place visited by more than 40,000 people every day show off the cultural diversity of Mauritius. See all the colorful fruits and vegetables displayed in the market, the exotic wares on offer.

Meet the local Herbal Medicinal man and get captivated by the fragrance of the tender dry leaves, sweet and strong eucalyptus, salsepareill, petit ginda or wild betel

Get closer to the harbor at the Caudan Waterfront where you can enjoy some shopping time and get to know more about the island's art and history at the Blue Penny Museum where the greatest treasure is the original unused version of the legendary postage stamp, the "Blue Mauritius"







Colorful South

Curepipe, Trou Aux Certs Volcano, Le Port Ship Modelling Factory, Typical Wine Factory, Grand Bassin Sacred Lake, Black River Gorges, Chamarel Village, Rhum Factory, 7 Colored Earth

Start in **Curepipe**, second biggest town with a rich historical background located at the foot of one of the oldest dormant volcano of the island the **Trou Aux Cerfs** where you enjoy a panoramic view over the surrounding mountains ranges and towns.

Discover the oldest and largest **Model Ship Factory** and watch the crafts people making the maquettes.

Continue to a **Mauritian Wine Factory**. - No vineyards, nor grapes, but surely an excellent wine made from a particular fruit! Created by a famous Mauritian Oenologist who will make you discover his treasure and taste them.

Head to **Grand Bassin**, a holy Hindus lake within an extinct volcano, famous for the Maha Shivaratree Festival, where each year more than 300,000 Hindus make pilgrimage to this place.

Trip continues through **the Black River Gorges National Park**. Mauritius Nature reserves occupying 3.5 percent of the island surface. 150 native plants and 9 endangered species of bird can only be found in this park. Several stops along the way so as to get splendid views of the beauty of this park.

Before reaching the **Chamarel Village**, we will stop at the its **Rhum Factory**. The factory itself is worth the visit, surrounded by sugarcane fields and tropical fruits. Get to learn the steps of this famous Rhum making, from the selection of the sugarcane, the distillation, the aging and finally taste the selection of fine rums and liqueurs produced exclusively on this site.

Lunch will be taken in a small typical Chamarel Restaurant.

Visit the famous **7 colored earth**. The undulated grounds spreads over approximately one hectare with as main color a rusty red. Depending on the time, the layers can look yellow, orange, blue or even purple.







Quatre Bornes Market, Mauritius Glass Gallery, Traditional Cuisine at inhabitant, Curepipe, Trou Aux Cerfs, Le Port Ship Model Factory

On Thursdays, in the residential and commercial town of **Quatre Bornes**, the fruit and vegetables **Local Market** set place to knitwear, shirts, jeans and all kind of accessories. A lively place which Mauritians are fond of. Stroll in the alleys of the market and be amazed by all the designs and colors of the cloths and products.

Head to the hub of Phoenix where the famous Mauritius Phoenix Beer factory faces the motorway, we will visit it's **Glass gallery**. An amazing experience in front of glass blowers shaping red-hot molten glass using simple traditional tools and 2000-years old methods. Each glass piece made from recycled bottles.

Our next stop is at two women's place in Midlands. Feel at ease in their house and their "traditional" Kitchen and see how they do cook these traditional Mauritian dishes as they were done by Grandparents long ago. Depending on the dishes on the day, you will be able to participate in the cooking process and get closer in your encounter with Mauritians.

We will head to **Curepipe**, second largest town, full of history and which boast of the best school, the Royal College, the basilica, St Helene Church and a three-aisled Roman Catholic Church in neogothic style, St Therese Church.

On top of the town, the **Trou Aux Cerfs**, a 250m/2130ft-high volcanic crater that gives both an insight into the island's geological history and a view over the whole Mauritius,

Visit the oldest and largest **Model Ship Factory** and watch the crafts people making these exceptional maquettes.





South Unspoilt

Bois Chéri Tea Factory, La Vanille Crocodile Park, Gris Gris, La Roche **Qui Pleure (Weeping Rock)**

South Unspoilt will show one of the traditional side of Mauritius through the visit of Bois Chéri, Tea Factory in the high land where the air is much cooler and tea plantations grows easily. In the tea factory, witness the transformation of this most appreciated beverage in Mauritius and discover a thousand and one secrets about tea in the Museum.

A stop will be made at a Chalet for a tasting session of the teas while enjoying a panoramic view on the south of the island.

Further in the south of the island, at Riviere des Anguilles, the visit continues at La Vanille Nature Parc. a picturesque and idvllic nature reserve extending over 3.5 hectares of luxuriant greenery.

In this breathtaking setting you will discover numerous animal species from the Mascarene islands but also more than 1500 Nile Crocodile being bred and reared from the young in the nursery to the fully-grown adults.

Giant Aldabra tortoises of 90 years old and more can also been seen.

An insectarium which houses one of the most extensive collections with more than 23000 species of butterflies, beetles, moths and other insects. Among other animals are the monkeys, wild boar, deer, frogs, colorful geckos and chameleons.

Relax in the tranguil setting of the parc restaurant and enjoy a Mauritian meal.

In the southern end of Souillac fishing village, enjoy a vantage point at Gris Gris where the coast is wild and the sea thrashes against the rocks making bathing lethal. Get a beautiful view of the waves a little further on from La Roche Qui Pleure, the "weeping rock".





lle Aux Aigrettes Nature Reserve, Traditional Biscuit Factory, Mahebourg Fishing Village, Naval Historic Museum

The tour starts with a short boat trip from Pointe Jerome in Mahebourg Village, **to Ile Aux Aigrettes Nature Reserve island.** Along with an ecotour ranger travel back in time to discover what Mauritius would have looked like 400 years ago before the arrival of man.

The small 27-hectare island is home to the last remnants of dry coastal forest. Rich in endemic plants such as the Ebony, Bois de Boeuf and Bois de Chandelle, you will also be able to see very rare birds as the **Pink Pigeons**, **the Mauritius Fody** all of which close to extinction a few years ago.

Within **Mahebourg village**, a family-owned **cassava biscuit factory** with traditional method, which has remained unchanged since its creation over 140 years ago.

The visit starts beneath a huge and almost centenary "Badam Tree" and the story telling begins with a secret family recipe. Learn on the process of the Biscuit Manioc making while ancient equipment still being used tells about the handicraft tradition.

Still in Mahebough village, enjoy a **Sino Mauritian cuisine** before continuing your visit. Along the way, our guide will give you lots of anecdotes and historical information of the village which was once the second most important city of the island,

The **National History Museum** in an 18th century mansion will relate more on the colonial time of the island and the naval war between French and England. 

Mahebourg Market, Traditional Biscuit Factory, Mahebourg Fishing Village, Naval Historic Museum, Blue Bay UNESCO Marine Parc

On Mondays, a colorful **weekly market** spread along Rue Hollandaise in Mahebourg offers an insight into daily life of Mauritius. Primarily aimed at locals, it is therefore a great attractions visiting it. The initial focus was silks and other textiles, but these days you'll find a busy produce section, tacky bricabrac and steaming food stalls. It is the perfect place to try some local snack.

Within Mahebourg village, a family-owned cassava biscuit factory with traditional method, which has remained unchanged since its creation over 140 years ago.

The visit starts beneath a huge and almost centenary "Badam Tree" and the story telling begins with a secret family recipe. Learn on the process of the Biscuit Manioc making while ancient equipment still being used tells about the handicraft tradition.

Still in Maheboug village, enjoy a **Sino Mauritian cuisine** before continuing your visit. Along the way, our guide will give you lots of anecdotes and historical information of the village which was once the second most important city of the island,

The **National History Museum** in an 18th century mansion will relate more on the colonial time of the island and the naval war between French and England. The museum attractions include a wreckage from the battle of 1810, a model of the 'St Geran' and one of the trains that used to travel across the island from 1864 to 1926

At **Blue Bay**, in the south of Mahebourg, climb aboard a **glass bottomed boat** from which you can explore the UNESCO marine park, marvel at beautiful coral formations and follow on with a snorkeling session among the colorful fishes in the lagoon.




You can then enjoy some **free relaxing time** at Le Morne beach and swim into its warm water. Have a **picnic Brunch** on the beach itself before continuing the trip.

Visit the famous **7 colored earth**. The undulated grounds spreads over approximately one hectare with as main color a rusty red. Depending on the time, the layers can look yellow, orange, blue or even purple. Though no clear scientific explanation, the hilly landscape is supposed to be volcanic in origin and is said to have been caused by mineral oxidation.

End your day adventure in a **Curious corner**, where your mind will be dazzled with illusions— See by yourself, what is real and what is just an illusion...

Our journey begins with coffee or fresh juice in the colonial house, 'Jardin de Beau Vallon'. Under the protective gaze of Lion Mountain, we head to 'Bois des Amourettes', a small village whose jetty, built during the Vieux Grand Port naval battle, provides an amazing view of the surrounding islets. (Optional)

Our next stop, the **Dutch-built 'Fréderick Hendrick Fort'**, the first stone building of the Indian Ocean. During the week, we meet **craftsmen** weaving traditional "vacoas" baskets, a dwin dling trade of Vieux Grand Port villagers for 200 years. (Upon request on weekends). You may even get the opportunity to participate in the weaving of baskets with the craftsmen

Afterwards we join up with Pop, one of the last "ranzer pirog" or **marine carpenters** of the island, and savour tamarind juice prepared by his wife, Salima.

We resume our journey and head towards the undulating landscape of 'Vallée de Ferney', a magnify cent wildlife reserve. An endemic plant (the Ebony tree) is set to be replanted there. Symbolic gesture to allow the reforestation of the Valley

Perched at the top of the Cliff, we sample the local menu for lunch at "Falaise rouge" restaurant while enjoying the panoramic view. Our route leads us to Cavendish Bridge where we cross La Chaux river and reach 'Ville Noire'. This neighboring village of Mahebourg is highly authentic, swarming with villagers and local merchants.

To the **seafront promenade** to admire the splendid view of the Vieux Grand Port Bay, Lion Mountain and Mouchoir Rouge Island. To end this journey in the heart of history, we go to the **National Historical Naval Museum** in Mahebourg located in an old colonial residence and showcasing an interesting collection of relics recovered from sunken ships, models, old maps and weapons, wonderful lithographs of remarkable Mauritians, landscape paintings and even the skeleton of the famous dodo... (The museum is closed on Wednesdays, Sundays and public holidays

Meeting at the Public beach of Poste Lafayette at 9 hr.

After covering the technical and safety measures we head out on the coastal road covering 2 kilometers on asphalt roads to get used to the bikes.

Row to the shore of Amber Island where the guide will show you some endemic plants, their names and virtues but also the history of the island as you come across the ruins of French homes dating from 1750.

Take a small rest to enjoy the surrounding before getting back on your kayak and rowing back to the main Island











On the East Coast, sail across the Trou d'Eau Douce Bay and experience a paradisiac day .

Time to answer the call of the ocean: out in the lagoon, immerse yourself in the crystal clear waters and snorkel among patches of staghorn coral, populated by minuscule fish and more odd-looking species

Back on board, the barbecue grill gets going as lunch will be served shortly... and what a great lunch that is: fresh fish and chicken grilled to perfection and served with a selection of salads and a side of garlic bread.

As the boat glides smoothly towards the waterfall of Grande Rivière Sud Est (GRSE). Jump onto a ferryboat that will take you right under the splash of the waterfall. The waterfall is modest in size, but the surrounding flora is reminiscent of a rainforest, with luscious creeping plants and trees lining either side.

Next stop: the famous Eastern islet we call lle aux Cerfs. The catamaran slips through a mangrove forest, an ideal nursery for the surrounding marine ecosystems. Ile aux Cerfs is unique in many ways: during the low season, the islet is an idyllic desert beach with calm, shallow waters that are safe even for young children. Explore the island on foot and find hidden coves on its other side.

The day ends as beautifully as it starts as the boat sails to mainland





It's time for a sunny getaway on the West Coast. Step on board the catamaran and look inland up at the Black River mountain range and the mythical Morne Mountain, named as part of World Heritage by UNESCO.

As the catamaran leaves the bay, the scenery unfolds in all hues of green and blue. Our first stop: Tamarin Bay. Keep an eye out for pods of spinner or bottlenose dolphins that stay in our western coastline waters

The boat then heads to Black River. In the lagoon, a patch reef about 2 metres deep, harbours colourful fishes and small crustaceans. Get into your snorkeling gear and chase after butterfly fish or tease passing trumpet fish while admiring the coral outcrops spread on the white sand.

On board, lunch awaits you. Feast on grilled fish and chicken with various salads, as well as bananas flambéed in rum for dessert, depending on the season.

Sail to the Bénitiers island and its famous Rock, which stands over the turquoise lagoon. Also, snap a picture next to this mysterious outcrop that features endlessly on Mauritian postcards Hop onto a fisherman's boat, which will ferry you to the island's sandy beaches, where you can laze around in the sun or start an exploration on foot.

Of course, you can also choose to stay on the catamaran and jump off the deck into the best swimming pool in the world: the Indian ocean!
